writing the letter at the hand of the Roman Emperor So Peter's second
epistle became his speech.
<u>Chapter 1</u>

One of the ways the false teachers were seducing believers into
living was by denying that Jesus was coming back and that there would be a reckoning.
Peter closes this last letter with a explanation of that very event.
